Applications are now being called for Men's, Women's and Mixed teams for the SUMMER SEASON 2008/09 which commences on Tuesday September 23, 2008 and will conclude on Thursday April 02, 2009.

Games will be fixtured from 6.30pm Mondays to Thursdays. Last time slot commences at 10:15pm.

Sunday MIXED competitions are played mid-afternoon and early evenings and MENS competitions are played mid-afternoon and throughout the evening.

The Association's new grading structure now identifies each night as a separate competition. Teams and players may play on more than one night at Nunawading Stadium. Players will only be allowed to be registered and play with one team on one night.

The only exception to this rule is where a player may play Mixed and Men/Women grades on the same night (Sunday & Tuesday).

There will be a **REGISTRATION Day** from 4:00pm to 10:00pm on Sunday August 24, 2008.

COST: Entry Fee: \$135 per team (which includes compulsory player insurance & GST component).
Bond: \$195 for all new teams (must be included with entry).

NO PAY – NO PLAY

All applications with payment received on or prior to **September 8, 2008** will be included in the 4 week grading fixtures. Entries (with payments) for **Existing and New Teams** received by this date will be given priority into the competitions. Entries received after that date will be used on a date received basis to fill vacancies still existing within each competition. Many teams with late entries choose to play on Sunday evening when they can't be accommodated on the night of their first choice.

Team applications must be accompanied by the **Entry Fee** and completed Registration Form. Please **PRINT CLEARLY** name and address and date of birth on registration form. It would be helpful if you printed the Players Details on a computer or typewriter so that the correct names are displayed on the Score Sheet. A signature is required from each player being registered.

Here are some Do's and Don't for teams and players

- **NO WHITE PLAYING TOPS** are permitted as the colour is reserved for the Association's alternative uniforms when a clash of colours occurs between teams. The first team named on the scoresheet must change if there is a clash of colour.
- Grand finalists will not have a break between seasons unless on a bye.
- **Teams** withdrawing from competition once fixtures have been printed will **forfeit their bond money**.
- **All** teams must be financial (Rego & Bond & Walkovers paid) to start in the competition and to compete in finals.
- Players **MUST** be registered. Failure to do so can mean that the game will be forfeited. There are two ways to register a player.
 1. complete the Player Registration Form and submit when you submit your Team Registration.
 2. Enter the Player's Name, Address, Birth Date and Signature on the back of the scoresheet on the first occasion they play.
- If a player's name does not appear printed on the Scoresheet, then the playing number, first name and last name must be completed on the front of the scoresheet. If the number only or number and first name only are written, then the game will be forfeited.
- The number "00" is NOT permitted and use will result in an "incorrect uniform" penalty of 10 points.
- Acceptance of a Team Name is at the discretion of the Senior Domestic Committee and inappropriate names will not be accepted.
- If playing under someone else's singlet number, your name must appear against that number on the front of the scoresheet.

WAYS YOU CAN HELP US:

- 1. Make sure you give us COMPLETE contact information for your team. Home, Work and Mobile Numbers are handy and we find that the Mobile number is the one we are able to contact most people on. Your email address is a good standby for us and with that, we can also advise you of news etc. The same information for a second contact (living at a different address) is required. Changes to these details MUST be notified to the Grade Secretary.**
- 2. Quite often, the number of players registered to a team makes it difficult to have all the names and numbers printed on the scoresheet. We suggest that you provide us with a list of 7 or 8 regular players with their standard numbers (and make sure they don't change). If you have fill in players, you hand write them (full name) on the scoresheet with their number as well as register them if necessary.**
- 3. If the use of alternate singlets is necessary, just write the temporary number in brackets after the name.**
- 4. If you know during the day of your game that you will be giving a walkover, please advise the grade secretary so that the other team can be notified so that they do not have to turn up. You would appreciate this courtesy if the situation were reversed.**
- 5. There is a \$65 charge for a walkover. Please make sure that this is paid before your next game. Failure to do so will attract a penalty of 3 premiership points for any game played while the levy is unpaid. Penalty points are not recoverable. You can phone the office (9802 6711) during the week after and pay by credit card.**
- 6. A penalty of 3 premiership points will also apply to any other unpaid amount including Registration Fees and Bond. Penalty points are not recoverable.**

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK APPROPRIATE FIXTURE BOARD FOR LADDERS AND TEAM NOTICES.

TEAM CONTACT: Please notify Grade Secretary of change of address and/or phone number.

NO PLAYER UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS IS PERMITTED TO PLAY SENIOR DOMESTIC COMPETITION BASKETBALL.

FINES: Walkover fine is \$65.00, and must be paid to the ticket box **BEFORE** next game. Failure to pay will invoke a 3 point penalty per game until the fine is paid.
Teams withdrawing from the competition once fixtures have been printed will forfeit their bond money.
Any team playing an **INELIGIBLE** player will be awarded a forfeit against them, 20 points to 0.

TO QUALIFY FOR FINALS:

PLAYERS MUST SIGN THEIR NAME AND NUMBER ON THE BACK OF THE SCORESHEET ON SIX (6) DIFFERENT OCCASIONS, SOME IN BOTH HALVES OF THE SEASON, OTHERWISE GAMES WILL NOT COUNT AS QUALIFYING FOR FINALS.

YOUR TEAM/CLUB MUST BE FINANCIAL TO PARTICIPATE IN FINALS.

SCORESHEETS:

Players first name or initials and last name must appear on the front of the scoresheet –**NO PREMIERSHIP POINTS** will be awarded if not done.

All players to sign the scoresheet **PRIOR** to match starting, or at **HALF TIME**, as scoresheets will be removed from the bench straight after the match.

FORGED signatures **WILL NOT** be accepted.

Any player not present to have name crossed out at end of game by the Scorer.

No names to be added to the scoresheet after commencement of game, unless player is present at the start and their name has been accidentally omitted from the scoresheet.

SCORING: Teams must ensure that a **COMPETENT** scorer is provided for any game in which their team is engaged. Each team **MUST** have one representative on the score bench. Scoresheets **MUST** be finished off and checked prior to team scorers leaving bench.

REGISTRATION:

Must be made each new season by **ALL** players. This is done by sending in a team list with your team registration. Extra players can be registered through the season by detailing on back of scoresheet in first played games of each new season: **PRINT** - Full name and address, player number and signature.

INJURIES: Note of injury **MUST** be recorded on back of scoresheet.

Insurance claim forms are available from: Nunawading Basketball Stadium, General Office 9am to 3:30pm Mon - Fri, phone 9802 6711.

NAILS: Nails to be checked prior to commencement of game. Nails can be taped with elastoplast finger nail tape only. No gloves allowed unless a doctor's certificate is produced (grade secretary must also to be notified of this situation).

JEWELLERY: Flat wedding rings only allowed if TAPED. All other jewellery must be removed prior to taking the court.

HAIR: Long hair can be in PONY TAILS ONLY. Plaits, base of the neck pony tails and hair beads are NOT allowed.

SHORTS: All team members must have shorts of uniform length and colour, i.e. mid or short. **NO POCKETS** allowed.

UNIFORMS: Size of numbers to be in line with rules governing competition - width no less than 2cm. Height front 10cm, back 20cm. Teams with shabby/old/faded uniforms will be requested to replace same. No white uniforms allowed. **T-SHIRTS** worn under singlet must be same colour as the singlet.

COLOUR CLASHES – Home teams must change singlets (team named first on fixture is regarded as home team). White singlets can be hired from the ticket office.

00 is not a legal singlet number- use will result in “incorrect uniform” penalty of 10 points.

The Committee reserves the right to reject wording on singlets and shorts that is offensive. This includes team names, player names, sponsors or other wording.
